Parents are the most strengthening power in moulding the future of a child. Their consistent support empowers us to do more and more. I sincerely pay my gratitude to them for their faith in us.



#### **CONFESSIONS OF AN ARMY BRAT**

So what is our life like?? Here are a few confessions from an army brat. NO! That doesn't mean that I'm spoilt or an ill mannered child! I'm an Army Brat, " Born , Raised And Transferred "

We are a typical tribe. There are certain attributes unique to us and our families. Let me tell you.

What the people around us see are amazing parties, fine dining in the mess, enjoying discounts too good to be true at military canteens and free medical facilities. What people don't know about us is the brave face our mothers put up when deep inside they are terrified for the safety of their husbands. Single parenting and multi-tasking are the biggest challenges and trust me, it's more arduous than it sounds.

We just don't get enough opportunities to stay together because that's how life in fauj is. We look forward to the times when our father would take leave and we would spend time together as a family. May be just twice a year.

And that is the time we get pampered the most by our father who just wants to make up for all the times that he's missed with us.

Though peace postings are a different ball game altogether.

On a lighter note, you get to learn so many terms when Dad is around. Fauji lingo is one of its kind. From BPT, ROGER, ADM Bandobast, Detailment, Fall-in, AWWA..... Courses named YOS, WCC, TSOC, DSSC, JC, HC etc. to even exams like Part B, Part D, to name some. Whoever said studies ended after being in the army was a big time liar.

There are n number of uniforms that officers have-- Games dress, number one dress, number two dress, combat dress, SD, 6Alpha, 6Bravo, Blue Patrol, {Pheww!!} and many more. Even mom has a hard time catching up with his precision and time management to change into a dress from morning to evening.

Infact going to a party is a "parade". Dining ins, dining outs, corps days {read as core} are the formal parties which children are banned from attending. Postings in army can be at the weirdest of places like Lalgadjatta {Rajasthan}, Tenga and Pasighat {north-east}, Likhabali, Rangiya, Lansdowne.....etc.

As army kids we learn our A,B,C,D.....as Alpha, Bravo, Charlie, Delta, Echo. It is never 5 a.m. it's 0500 hrs.

Dad is a pro at eating rice with a fork and also use the fork to push the dal and veggies to the roti. That's just how all officers eat and expect us too, to 'open' and 'close' our plates with complete table manners.

And how can I forget to mention the part that I get most teased upon !!!! the DHAI TON --- it's the olive green open tent like covered truck which is my unique school bus.{an inseparable part of any army kid}

Another interesting and crucial part in our lives is played by the fauji barber, who comes home every few days to give our dad a haircut and that is when we as kids also end up bearing the brunt of his scissors and thereby most of the army brats end up looking alike after a hair cut as the barber is an expert at the crew cut— the only style he knows.

There are endless number of "Shoes and Caps" found in an army household. Stomping around the house in your dad's boots and saluting everyone around you are the most cherished memories as a child. My stories are endless, and I can narrate each one with equal pride and love. Yes it is difficult being away from my father, not seeing him for months. But that's life for us and we pack years up in black painted boxes and move to a new place to start all over again.

That's the beauty of this organization and I appreciate its value like no one else.
